

**TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE
ORDINANCE NO. 2009-20**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE
AMENDING CHAPTER 134-43 SCHEDULE XI. OF THE
FLORENCE TOWNSHIP CODE TO AMEND DESIGNATE UNION
STREET AS A STOP STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF
BODINE STREET.**

Whereas, the Township Council has determined that it is necessary to designate Union Street as a stop street at the intersection of Bodine Street; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134-43 Schedule XI to add the following as a stop street, with a stop sign to be installed in advance of the intersecting street in accordance with 134-13:

Stop Sign On

At Intersection of

Union Street

Bodine Street

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.
