It sounds unbelievable, but it's true. A brand new "shell" company has been created solely for the purpose of building a hazardous waste incinerator less than half a mile from the Delaware River at the Bridge Business Center site in Bristol Township.

A hazardous waste incinerator, besides being an eyesore, will pose a grave health threat to our families, our river and the overall environments of Bucks, Burlington and Mercer Counties.

When asked what the incinerator will burn, the answer is "hazardous waste." No one from Rt.13 Bristol Partners, LP was able to elaborate. We do know what will be released into the air, water and environment if this application is approved:

- ✗ Airborne dioxins and furans that are, even in miniscule amounts, *the most toxic chemicals known to science*. Dioxins can cause infertility, learning disabilities, endometriosis, birth defects, sexual reproductive disorders, damage to the immune system, cancer and more!

If a hazardous waste incinerator has to be built anywhere, it should be far away from a densely populated community like Bristol.

This project must be stopped. Please join elected officials on both sides of the river and the angry citizens of New Jersey and Pennsylvania who have come together to OPPOSE the building of a hazardous waste incinerator in Bristol.
