

2014 BUDGET – OVERVIEW

The 2014 budget was introduced on April 2, 2014 and is scheduled for introduction on Wednesday, May 7, 2014. The public hearing will be held in the Municipal Building at 8 p.m.

The 2014 budget maintains all municipal services without increasing the local purpose tax (LPT). The local purpose tax for 2014 remains the same as the local purpose tax for 2013. A breakdown of the actual tax rate and budget numbers is outlined below.

Florence Township will be initiating a Road Improvement Program this year and a list of the roads scheduled to be repaved this spring is contained on the municipal website. The Mayor and Township Council will also be approving an additional Road Program for the spring of 2015. A complete listing of the roads to be improved in 2015 will be identified on the website by late summer or early fall. It is the goal of Mayor Wilkie and Township Council to implement a Road Improvement Program every year for the foreseeable future.

The Mayor and Township Council are also pleased to announce that the Patriotic Celebration will take place on Saturday, July 12, 2014. More detailed information about the parade and fireworks display will be forthcoming in the coming months. The Patriotic Celebration is an event that celebrates not only our heritage, but also Florence Township's community spirit.

Florence Township will continue to not only make infrastructure improvements this year, but we will also begin to upgrade old and aging vital equipment in the Public Works Department, Water and Sewer Department and Police Department. A new street sweeper is scheduled to arrive in late April 2014, and the Cedar Lane Water Tower is presently out of service for maintenance improvements and painting.




2014 CURRENT FUND BUDGET




