Program**

Would you like help with preparing your Federal and State Income Tax Returns?

Would you like to be able to receive your refunds within 2 weeks of filing?

Would you like to have them prepared and e-filed for free?

Florence Township is offering through the IRS VITA program, the opportunity for volunteers to complete tax returns for taxpayers who meet some basic requirements.

1. \$50,000 or less income for single (\$100,000 for married filing jointly)
2. Simple tax returns (No Itemized Deductions or Business Returns)
3. No investment returns (those with many stock trades throughout the year)
4. More details listed on website and posters at Township Building and Library

Tax Returns will be completed starting early February through about April 10th. Don't wait until the last day. The earlier you get them completed, the earlier you get your money back from the government.

FILE TAX RETURNS

Learn more about federal taxes and help others in your community

Last year, more than 76,000 Americans gave something to their communities and can't wait to do it again this year. According to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), what they gave was their time.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) volunteers prepare simple federal and state tax returns for people whose incomes are \$50,000 or less. Anyone can volunteer. If you are interested and want to help, we can find a way to involve you in this program.

The IRS provides free training materials to community organizations that sponsor VITA. Training classes will be held at the Florence Township Library in Roebling, NJ. The training will be held in mid-January. Tax Returns will be completed at the library from early February through April 10th.
