



VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO HELP PEOPLE FILE TAX RETURNS

Learn more about federal taxes and help others in your community

Last year, more than 76,000 Americans gave something to their communities and can't wait to do it again this year. According to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), what they gave was their time.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) volunteers prepare simple federal and state tax returns for people whose incomes are \$53,000 or less. Anyone can volunteer. If you are interested and want to help, we can find a way to involve you in this program.

The IRS provides free training materials to community organizations that sponsor VITA. Training classes will be held at the Florence Township Library in Roebling, NJ. The training will be held in late-January. Tax Returns will be completed at the library from early February through April 11th.
