ORDINANCE 2011-04

An Ordinance of the Township of Florence Amending Chapter 134 – Traffic, Article IVA of the Florence Township Code to Establish Permit Parking Requirements on a Portion of Second Avenue from Hornberger Avenue to Main Street

Whereas, the Township Council has determined that it is necessary to establish permit parking requirements on certain streets in order to provide a fair and reasonable allocation of parking for the residents of those streets.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Traffic, Article IVA, to read as follows (§134.25.2 is being added to the existing provisions):

**ARTICLE IVA
Permit Parking**

§ 134-25.1. Florence Housing Authority Maplewood Homes Resident Parking Permit

- a. Parking on the east side of Zinc Street and the southerly terminus of Zinc Street shall be limited to the automobiles owned, operated or in the possession of a resident owner or tenant of any property abutting the easterly side of Zinc Street or the southerly terminus of Zinc Street, which vehicle shall display a current Florence Housing Authority Maplewood Homes resident parking permit. The Florence Housing Authority is authorized to issue one resident parking permit to each such owner or tenant.
- b. Vehicles parking on the east side of Zinc Street or the southerly terminus of Zinc Street and not displaying a valid Florence Housing Authority Maplewood Homes resident parking permit shall be in violation of this Article and shall be subject to the fines imposed by this chapter.
- c. Nothing contained in ~ 134-24.1 shall be deemed to permit parking on Zinc Street where such parking is otherwise prohibited or restricted.

§ 134.25.2 Permit Parking Restricted to Residents on a portion of Second Avenue

- a. The streets designated below shall be restricted to resident on-street parking by permit. Not more than two (2) parking permits shall be issued to each residential property for the use of the owner or tenant of the property located on the portion of the street where the restricted parking is

in effect. The permit shall allow on-street parking, on a space available basis, on the specific street or portion of the street on which the residential property is located.

- b. The permit parking restriction shall be in effect between the hours of 4:00 PM and 8:00 AM daily.
- c. The parking permits shall be for a period of two (2) calendar years and may be renewed by the property owner. Whenever the party holding the permit moves from the address where the permit is applicable, the permit shall be surrendered to the Township Clerk.
- d. The permit shall be displayed so that it is visible from the outside of the vehicle, through the front window on the driver's side.
- e. It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any vehicle not displaying a valid permit to be parked on the designated street, during the restricted hours
- f. The permit parking restriction shall not apply to emergency vehicles for police, fire or emergency medical response.
- g. The Chief of Police may issue a temporary parking permit to allow a moving van to be parked overnight on the street where the van is being used for moving in or out of a property on the street where the restrictions would otherwise apply.
- h. Permits shall be issued by the Township Clerk. Residents requesting permits shall produce a valid driver's license showing the address of the property entitled to a permit.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by law.

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Take Notice that the Ordinance identified above amends Chapter 134 - Traffic of the Florence Township Code to establish permit parking requirements between the hours of 4:00 PM and 8:00 AM on Second Avenue between Hornberger Avenue and Main Street in order to provide a fair and reasonable allocation of parking for the residents of those streets. Permits will be limited to two parking permits per residence on the designated streets. The Ordinance has been adopted on first reading by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on April 20, 2011. It was amended on May 4, 2011, to delete the provision that the vehicle had to be registered at the address qualifying for the permit. It will be considered for final passage after a public hearing to be held on May 18, 2011, at 8:00 P.M. in the Municipal Complex, Council Chambers, 711 Broad Street, Florence, New Jersey.
