Establish a term of service for Emeritus Members serving on the  
Economic Development Committee**

**Whereas**, the Township Council has determined that it is appropriate to provide for an Economic Development Committee to provide advice to the Mayor and Township Council with regard to the economic development and marketing of the Township,

**Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained** by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

**Section 1.** Chapter 5-2 of the Code of the Township of Florence is amended and supplemented to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 5**

**ADVISORY COMMITTEES**

**ARTICLE I**

**Economic Development Committee**

§ 5-2 Appointment of the Economic Development Committee.

The members of the Economic Development Committee shall be appointed to one (1) year terms. All terms shall begin on January 1<sup>st</sup> and shall end on December 31<sup>st</sup>. Vacancies shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the original appointment for the unexpired term of the member whose vacancy is being filled.

Six (6) of the members shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council.

Up to four (4) ex-official members, who were active voting members of the Economic Development Committee for a minimum twenty years in total, maybe appointed by the Mayor with consent of Council. Their term ends when they no longer reside in Florence Township or they resign the position. These Members Emeritus have all the rights and privileges of the regular members, except their attendance is not required, they do not count towards quorum and they are not voting members.

**Section 2.** If a court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

**Section 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall become effective after proper passage and publication in accordance with the law.

**Take Notice** that the Ordinance identified above amends the Florence Township Code to establish a minimum term of service for Emeritus Members serving on the Economic Development Committee. Any Emeritus Members to be appointed by the Mayor and approved by Council, must have served a minimum twenty (20) years in total, as a voting member, on the Economic Development Committee, prior to becoming eligible for Emeritus status.

The Ordinance has been adopted on first reading by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, held on 2-15-12. It will be considered for final passage after public hearing to be held on 3-7-12, at 8:00 P.M. in the Municipal Complex, Council Chambers, 711 Broad Street, Florence, New Jersey.
