ORDINANCE 2013-06

**An Ordinance of the Township Of Florence Amending
Chapter 110 of the Florence Township Code to Revise
Provisions of Parks and Recreation**

Whereas, the Township Council has determined that it is necessary to amend regulations for the use of public parks and recreation areas according to Chapter 110 of the Florence Township Code.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 110-1.(32) Unlawful acts to read as follows:

Take part in or abet the playing of any games involving thrown or otherwise propelled objects, such as balls, stones, javelins, arrows, horseshoes or model airplanes, except in those areas set apart for such forms of recreation. The playing of rough or comparatively dangerous games, such as football, baseball and lacrosse, is prohibited, except on the fields and courts or areas designated therefor. Roller skating shall be confined to those areas specifically designated for such purpose. Golfing and hitting of golf balls is prohibited unless otherwise specifically provided for in a particular park or location by the display of appropriately displayed signs.

Section 2. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.
