

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-15

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE,
IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY,
PROVIDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE
TOWNSHIP'S STREETS AND ROADS UNDER THE 2015
ROAD PROGRAM AND RELATED EXPENSES IN AND
FOR THE TOWNSHIP AND APPROPRIATING \$200,000
TO FUND THE SAME.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. For the purpose of making repairs to Township streets and roads, including regrading and repaving of roadway surfaces and subsurfaces, refurbishing or replacing curbs and sidewalks and undertaking drainage improvements, and each including all work and materials necessary to complete such improvements, including expenses incurred in the planning, design and bidding thereof, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$200,000 from the Township's General Capital Surplus Account.

Section 2. The roads and streets scheduled to be included in the 2015 Road Program are as follows:

Spruce Street (from Front Street to Fifth Street)

Spruce Street (from Ninth Street to Wilbur Henry Drive)

East Second Street (from Broad Street to Walnut Street)

West Third Street (from Broad Street to Summer Street)

Cedar Street (from Front Street to East Third Street)

East Third Street (from Cedar Street to Oak Street)

Third Avenue (Hornberger Avenue to Main Street)

Eighth Avenue (Hornberger Avenue to Main Street)

Intersection of Seventh Avenue and Riverside Avenue

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township shall be amended, if necessary, to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
