

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-29**

**AUTHORIZING THE TAX ASSESSOR OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE TO FILE APPEALS, OMITTED AND  
ADDED ASSESSMENT APPEALS, AND ROLL BACK COMPLAINTS WITH  
THE BURLINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF TAXATION**

WHEREAS, a statutory provision is made for review and correction of errors prior to certification of an assessment list; and

WHEREAS, provision is also allowed for the discovery and correction of errors after establishment of the tax rate; and

WHEREAS, changes in property ownership at times necessitates adjustments in the veteran's and/or senior citizen's deduction allowed on the assessment list; and

WHEREAS, responsibility for maintenance and correction of the assessment list rests with the local Tax Assessor subject to specific laws and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to file with the Burlington County Board of Taxation all such appeals, including Omitted and Added Assessment Appeals, as may be necessary to maintain accuracy and equality in the assessment list of the Township of Florence; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to file with the Burlington County Board of Taxation, Roll Back Complaints; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to execute Stipulations of Settlement on behalf of the Township of Florence; and


