RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL SUPPORT FOR CNDev NJ, LLC TO RECEIVE A CLASS 5 CANNABIS RETAILER LICENSE FROM THE NEW JERSEY CANNABIS REGULATORY COMMISSION TO OPERATE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE

WHEREAS, in 2020 New Jersey voters approved Public Question No. 1, which amended the New Jersey Constitution to allow for the legalization of a controlled form of marijuana called "cannabis" for adults at least 21 years of age; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Governor Murphy signed into law P.L. 2021, c.16, known as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act" (the "Act"), which legalizes the recreational use of marijuana by adults 21 years of age or older, and establishes a comprehensive regulatory and licensing scheme for commercial recreational (adult use) cannabis operations, use and possession; and

WHEREAS, the Act establishes six (6) marketplace classes of licensed cannabis businesses, specifically including Class 5 cannabis retailer licenses; and

WHEREAS, Section 31a of the Act authorizes municipalities to adopt by ordinance the number of Class 5 cannabis retailer licenses that will be available in a municipality; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2024 the Florence Township Council adopted Ordinance 2024-10 (the "Ordinance"), which established that the number of cannabis retail licenses in the Township shall not exceed one (1); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2024-10 established that licensed operations shall be permitted in specific zoning districts and portions of the Township, as conditional uses; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission issued guidance to the State's municipalities on December 10, 2021, in which it stated the following:

Municipalities that limit the number of cannabis businesses allowed to operate within the municipal borders should not issue letters or resolutions of support in excess of the number of cannabis businesses allowed to operate within the border unless such letters or resolutions of support specify that license applicants that receive Commission approval first in time shall be deemed approved by the municipality until the local license limit is reached.

WHEREAS, CNDev NJ, LLC has requested the Township's support to locate a Class 5 cannabis retailer business in the Township; and

WHEREAS, CNDev NJ, LLC submitted an application including a detailed financial analysis and concept plan for the Township's review; and

WHEREAS, representatives of CNDev NJ, LLC met with Township Staff including Administration, Codes, Police, and Zoning to present the proposal to establish a cannabis retailer business in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Staff have determined that the cannabis retailer license being sought may operate subject to Planning Board approval within the Township at the proposed location; and

WHEREAS, the proposed location for CNDev NJ, LLC is 2037 Route 130, Burlington (Florence Township) NJ, and is reflected on the Official Tax Map of the Township of Florence as Block 159, Lot 4.02, in the "HC" Highway Commercial Zoning District and such location is permitted as a conditional use for said Class 5 cannabis retailer business; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council recognizes that the location proposed by CNDev NJ, LLC complies with local codes and ordinances, as they relate to proximity to various uses and zones in the Township of Florence; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2024-10, the number of cannabis retail licenses in the Township shall not exceed three (3); and

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, no other cannabis retail businesses exist in the Township of Florence, no other cannabis retailer has been approved for licensure to be located in the Township of Florence; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, in the County of Burlington, in State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are hereby incorporated as if restated herein in full.
- The Township Council of Florence Township find and determine that CNDev NJ, LLC
 has presented Florence Township with sufficient evidence that it is ready, willing
 and able to operate a successful and safe cannabis business within Florence
 Township.
- 3. Florence Township has set a limit of three (3) Class 5 cannabis retail businesses under the Ordinance. The issuance of a Class 5 cannabis retailer license CNDev NJ, LLC by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission would not exceed that limit.
- 4. Florence Township has imposed a limit on the number of cannabis licenses, and asserts that, pursuant to the State's guidance, the license applicants that receive Commission approval first in time shall be deemed approved by the municipality until the local business limit is reached (subject to all necessary planning board approvals and local license approvals).
- 5. The Township Council of Florence Township formally express their support for CNDev NJ, LLC with respect to its application to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission for a Class 5 cannabis retailer license.
- 6. Nothing in this Resolution shall preclude the Township Council from issuing additional resolutions or letters of municipal support to other applicants, to the extent that may be permissible under the regulations promulgated by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission, nor shall it limit the Township Council's authority with respect to any request for input from the Cannabis Regulatory Commission as to their preferred licensee.
- 7. Nothing in this Resolution is intended to affirm that CNDev NJ, LLC will ultimately be granted a license from Florence Township to operate a cannabis business within Florence Township, as evidence of compliance with Florence Township's laws, zoning law, and regulations will be required to be demonstrated by the applicant at the appropriate time.
- 8. A certified copy of this resolution shall be provided to the appropriate representatives of CNDev NJ, LLC.
