

2023 Florence Township Leaf Collection

Florence Township has begun leaf collection and will be implementing a guide for residents to follow which will identify our township in “zones”. We will post which zone will be collected on a week-to-week basis during the collections season. This will allow residents to know roughly when our crews will be traveling through your area so that you can move your leaves curbside to be collected. We will be making several passes through each zone and will notify residents when collection season has ended.

Please be conscious of leaves that are on or near stormwater inlets. It is very important to keep those areas clear. Public Works will do its best to clear these inlets as this time of year it is inevitable that accumulation will take place.

We ask that residents make attempts to place leaves curbside, nearest the edge of your property without piling leaves on the actual street. Leaves located on driving areas can create hazards and have an affect on the flow of storm water. **Leaf piles should ONLY contain leaves. Other yard debris cannot be picked up by the Leaf Vacuum Truck and may cause damage to our equipment.**

Please do not place leaves in your trash container. Bagged leaves must be separated from trash and leaf piles.

All residents have the opportunity to drop off leaves at the Florence Township Recycling Center. Loose leaves are to be located in the assigned bin and all bagged leaves must be emptied into the bin upon drop off. The Florence Township Recycling Center hours of operation are as follows:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday: 11:00am to 5:00pm

Saturday: 9:00am to 3:00pm

Closed: Wednesday and Sunday
