Attached please find the recommendation for Partial payment No. 2 as it related to the Potts Mill Road Phase III Improvements in Florence Township.

Status of Construction:

EA has maintained traffic around the worksite properly and in accordance with the plans.

All concrete curbing, sidewalks, ramps, driveways, and walls are complete. All concrete items had DGA installed and compacted as a solid base.

EA has completed installation of beam guiderail and guiderail end terminals and have applied the proper non-vegetative surface treatment under and around newly installed guiderail.

EA has completed the improvement of slopes adjacent to newly installed sidewalk using riprap and other slope stabilization measures.

EA has completed turf strip repairs, and have topsoiled, seeded, and fertilized areas in accordance with the contract specifications. The job is shut-down until April 1st when the asphalt plants re-open. The job will be 100-percent completed in April 2022.

There are some concrete sidewalks and curbs that will require removal and replacement due to poor workmanship/materials. This will be done in April prior to paving.

Recommendation of Partial Payment Number 2:

The total amount of work completed to date is \$309,016.07 with a 2% retainage amount of \$6,180.32, less payment 1 in the amount of \$204,594.30; leaves a partial payment due in the amount of \$98,241.45 to the general contractor.
