AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE AND BURLINGTON COUNTY FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

WHEREAS, Burlington County determined that pedestrian safety at the intersection of Cedar Lane and Olive Street/Firehouse Lane would be greatly improved by the installation of Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons; and

WHEREAS, Florence Township Council agrees that a pedestrian traffic control signal is necessary at the intersection of Cedar Lane and Olive Street/Firehouse Lane and agrees to enter into a Shared Services Agreement with Burlington County regarding installation, maintenance and electrical power of traffic control devices.

WHEREAS, the Shared Services Agreement will require Florence Township to pay for 50% of the cost of installation, the monthly electrical service and provide police officers if required for the maintenance of the installation; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Township of Florence, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that it hereby authorizes a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Burlington for the installation of traffic control devices at the intersection of Cedar Lane and Olive Street/Firehouse Lane.
