WHEREAS, the Florence Township School District requested that the Township Planning Board undertake a Capital Projects Review of the proposed project pursuant to the provisions of NJSA 40:55D-31, for a determination as to whether the proposed project is substantially consistent with the Township's duly adopted Master Plan Land;

WHEREAS, at the Planning Board's regular meeting on November 22, 2022, the School District's Engineer, Robert Stout, PE, of Stout & Caldwell, presented the proposed project in conceptual form to the Board;

WHEREAS, the School District's representative made clear that the project was being presented in concept form only and that fully engineered drawings would be prepared and again presented to the Planning Board for review and comment if a pending funding application to the State is approved, and detailed engineering is thereby funded and justified;
