**ORDINANCE 2024-15** 

BOND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-17, FINALLY ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 18, 2019 TO INCREASE SECTION 20 AUTHORIZATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), pursuant to the Local Bond Law, Chapter 169 of the Laws of the State of New Jersey, as amended and supplemented ("Local Bond Law"), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6(d) of Bond Ordinance 2019-17, finally adopted September 18, 2019 (the 'Prior Ordinance') is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. (d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$1,750,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the improvements or purposes.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget (as applicable) of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or amended temporary capital budget (as applicable) and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Township Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 3. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township Council of the Township of Florence, in the County of Burlington, New Jersey on October 2, 2024, and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

TITLE:

BOND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FLORENCE, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-17, FINALLY ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 18, 2019, TO ADD ADDITIONAL PURPOSE

SUMMARY: Ordinance 2019-17, finally adopted September 18, 2019 (the "Prior Ordinance") authorized various improvements to the Township's Water Plant to be undertaken by the Township and appropriated money, and authorized debt, to pay for these projects. This ordinance would amend the Prior Ordinance to increase the amount of money that can be spent to pay "section 20" costs (e.g. costs related to planning, design, architects, survey, accounting, legal, etc. related to the improvement) from \$1,000,000 to \$1,750,000. The Township plans to use this increased authorization to evaluate and design a new water treatment process to mitigate PFOS pollution found in the Township's well water. NO NEW DEBT IS AUTHORIZED BY THIS AMENDMENT.
