RESOLUTION NO. 2024-210 RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2024-198 APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MUNICIPAL TAX ASSESSOR AND APPOINTING ASSISTANT TO THE ASSESSOR

WHEREAS, Tax Assessor Thomas Colavecchio had tenured his retirement effective December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that Florence Township appoint the Tax Assessor's successor to begin working with the assessor in order to achieve a seamless transition in the Tax Assessor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Administrator have interviewed and qualified Justin Lamicella, Sr., SCGREA/CTA to be appointed as Deputy Tax Assessor.

WHEREAS, we were notified by the State of New Jersey that there is no provision in the statute for a temporary appointment of Deputy Tax Assessor and Resolution 2024-198 should be rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Florence, Burlington County, New Jersey, that Resolution 2024-198 is rescinded and *Justin Lamicella*, *Sr.*, hereby appointed as the Assistant to the Tax Assessor effective November 1, 2024; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that compensation as Assistant to the Tax Assessor shall be paid at a rate of \$55/hr. for hours worked onsite in the Tax Assessors Office for the period of November 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024, said compensation is not to exceed \$5,500.00 for the period.
