ORDINANCE 2025-20

An Ordinance of the Township of Florence Amending Chapter 134 of the Florence Township Code to Establish One-Way Traffic and Parking Restrictions on Roland Street and Parking Restrictions on a Portion of Alden Avenue and to Establish a Stop Intersection for Roland Street and Norman Avenue

Whereas, the Township Administrator and the Chief of Police of the Township of Florence have recommended that Roland Street be designated as a one-way street; and

Whereas, the Township Administrator and Chief of Police further recommend that certain parking restrictions are established on Roland Avenue and also on a portion of Alden Avenue to provide for public safety and emergency vehicle access; and

Whereas, by virtue of establishing Roland Street as a one-way street, a stop intersection is required for Roland Street at Norman Avenue; and

Whereas, the Township Council has considered the recommendations of the Township Administrator and the Chief of Police and determines that it is necessary: (i) to designate Roland Street as a one-way street, (ii) establish parking restrictions on a portion of Roland Street and also on a portion of Alden Avenue, and (iii) establish a stop intersection at Roland Street and Norman Avenue.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Township Council of the Township of Florence that:

Section 1. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Section 41, Schedule IX: One-Way Streets to add the following provisions:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Direction or Travel</u>	<u>Limits</u>
Roland Street	East	Entire Length

Section 2. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Section 43, Schedule XI: Stop Intersections to repeal the Stop Sign provision for Roland Street and Alden Avenue and to add Roland Street and Norman Avenue to such Schedule XI to now read as follows:

Stop Sign On
Roland Street

At Intersection Of
Norman Avenue


Section 3. The Code of the Township of Florence is hereby amended by revising Chapter 134, Section 33, Schedule I: No Parking to add the following provisions:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>
Roland Street	North	From Alden Avenue to a point 35 ft East thereof.
Alden Avenue	East	From Roland Street to a point 25 feet North thereof.


Section 4. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.

Section 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Florence heretofore adopted that are inconsistent with any of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage. Notice of adoption shall be published as provided by law.
